

WHAT WE BELIEVE

At Roche Bobois, we believe that design, quality and environmental responsibility are closely entwined: a product is creative and high-quality only when it respects the environment at large.

Since 2005, we have been dedicated to transforming Roche Bobois into a more virtuous brand.

This journey began by adopting an evaluation tool to quantify the environmental impact of our products, and to improve existing collections whenever possible.

Secondly, we have gradually integrated environmental performance into every aspect of product development, starting at its design phase.

Today, our eco-design strategy is an ongoing investment that underpins a wider commitment to improving the entire value chain: from design to manufacturing, transport, logistics, and recycling.







OUR GOALS

We are committed to positioning Roche Bobois as an international leader in the manufacturing of environmentally friendly furniture.

To that end, we have set ambitious targets that undergo continuous monitoring:

 reducing the carbon footprint of all Roche Bobois activities through multiple initiatives carried out internally and with our partners;

 expanding our supply of sustainable materials and wood from sustainable forests that adhere to FSC/PEFC standards;

 improving the sustainability of materials beyond regulatory requirements;

 increasing the proportion of newly ecodesigned products by 20% annually. In 2025, 100% of new Roche Bobois products will qualified as eco-designed.

OUR EVALUATION TOOL, THE ECO8 LABEL

Our eco-design approach is based on a powerful quality evaluation tool: Eco8. This tool was developed in 2011, with the assistance and expertise of FCBA*, a leading French technology institute.

It carries out an evaluation based on 8 criteria that analyse the product's life cycle, from the design stage through to recycling:

the materials considered for its manufacturing, the quality of their environmental profile;

 manufacturing: assembly methods and the environmental practices implemented in workshops;

- use: product durability and ease of repair;

 recycling: the amount of materials used, their separability and their end-of-life safety.

OUR COMMITMENT

Roche Bobois only considers products that achieve or exceed 75% of the maximum score as eco-designed.


As of 2023, over 60% of our new Roche Bobois products meet the criteria for ecodesign. This number is constantly increasing.


Hans Hopfer

Painter, sculptor and designer Hans Hopfer has been designing sofas since the 1970s, with some of them becoming iconic pieces in the Roche Bobois collections. Sensitive to changing lifestyles and creative space management, he designed seats with fully modular, floor-level units. In 1971, he created the Mah Jong sofa: a system of cushions

that champion complete freedom of form and function. Avant-garde at the time of its creation, it is an iconic piece today. Upholstered in fabrics designed by Kenzo Takada, Missoni and Jean Paul Gaultier, the Mah Jong has long set the standard for creative modularity.







Kenzo Takada

As the first Japanese stylist to make waves in Paris, Kenzo Takada's particularly innovative style features original combinations borrowed from the world of Parisian fashion and Japanese poetry. In the 1970s, he introduced his unique fusion style to the world, showcasing a distinctive fashion interweaving eastern and western influences. From the 1980s, he started designing menswear, explored the world of perfume

and embarked on multiple collaborations. For Roche Bobois, Kenzo Takada has designed exceptional collections of fabrics and ceramics. They feature the designer's hallmark graphic and cultural signatures: a mixed aesthetic, color mastery, and subtle patterns. In dressing the iconic Mah Jong sofa, he drew inspiration from the historical kimonos worn in Japan's Noh theatre, revisiting their patterns and color schemes.

Nicknamed the "enfant terrible" of French fashion, this French designer and stylist likes to break with convention, reinvent classics, and play up opposites. Jean Paul Gaultier draws on humor and irreverence. His fashion is festive, iconoclastic, and celebrates diversity. The discerning eye of the the French designer combined with Roche Bobois' savoir-faire has given life to a collection that

unveils the profound interplay between fashion and decoration. A poetic, sophisticated collection composed of a mix of fragrances, sensual materials, and subtle contrasts. In his reinterpretation of the Mah Jong sofa, he freely juxtaposes his signature sailor stripes with tattoo designs, kitsch roses, and a romantic photograph. Mixing up genres is one of his signatures.




Song Wen Zhong

A graduate of the Beijing Art Academy, Song Wen Zhong's talent has garnered recognition through several awards in both China and Europe. He won the first edition of the Roche Bobois Design Award based on the theme of "Nature, universal link between East and West". For Roche Bobois, he designed Ava – a chair that weaves together Chinese symbolism, advanced

technology, and environmental responsibility. Made of polycarbonate injection derived from recycled industrial waste, the matte version is manufactured without any new oil-based materials. Since his early collaboration with Roche Bobois, Song Wen Zhong has opened his own design studio in his hometown of Chengdu.






















Eugeni Quitllet

Trained at La Llotja school of Art and Design in Barcelona, this Catalan designer has collaborated with Philippe Starck with whom he co-created over 50 projects. Eugeni Quittlet's creative vocabulary encompasses more than the relationship between function and style. At the intersection of design, sculpture and contemporary archaeology,

he literally reveals forms hidden in matter in an elegant interplay of fullness and emptiness. For Roche Bobois, he designed Pulp – a collection of furniture and chairs with a biomorphic aesthetic. Inspired by the living world, Pulp draws on the dissociation of elements: the designer envisioned each piece as a cluster of molecules.





Antoine Fritsch and Vivien Durisotti are constantly seeking to strike a balance between people and their environment. Each project is approached with a holistic vision to achieve a relevant, meaningful outcome in terms of use. Their projects generally involve a process of sharing or dialogue; collaborations lending poetry and depth

to their designs. As fervent advocates of positive design, they are committed to reducing the environmental impact of their designs. Many of them qualify as ecodesigned, such as the Corail table (see the following page) - a technical and poetic feat made of 3D-printed concrete and fully customizable.
